Lemon  
Sugar  
Hot water

### **THE RUM AND CIGAR BLAZOR**

Appleton's 21yo  
Rosso Antico  
Cigar Liquor  
Angostura Bitters

*Let the notes of the Appleton's shine through, with hints of vanilla, smoke and chocolate, and the balance of the sweet subtle cigar follow you in this drink....*

*' Blazers have been around for over a century but they seemed to get lost through time, with Prohibition and the Tiki era that was to follow they almost go left behind... today bartenders are starting to realize that these drinks are complex and exciting. The next two Blazers are a modern take of the classic style.'*

### **BITTER JOY**

Appleton's 12yo  
Averna  
Mandarin Napoleon  
Chili  
Chocolate Bitters  
Hot water

*The rich chocolate notes with a hint of spice are a perfect way to end your evening. Let the flavors open up from the heat at the start to the mellow sweetness at the end with the mandarin.*

### **BUFFALO RETREAT**

Buffalo Trace  
Cinnamon liquor  
Chorizo sugar  
Sweet vermouth  
Old fashioned Bitters

*This is a full flavored blazer with the meaty characters working in harmony with the sweeter style of Bourbon. Matched with the sweet vermouth it will give you a long lasting finish.*

*'Although these drinks are a serious style and complex, we are fortunate enough to have some amazing products to work with. These next two blazers are all about experimenting and having fun with the drinks... They are slightly sweeter in style and have some interesting flavors if you dare'*

### **BANANA AND AGAVE BLAZOR**

Jose Cuervo  
Grand Mariner  
Banana and Agave liquor  
Orange Bitters  
Water

*The Rich tequila with hints of wood and spice work in balance with the Rich agave notes of the liquor.  
The Banana is light and subtle throughout.*

### **JACKIES RED HOT RUM**

Havana 7yo  
Crème de Framboise  
Rosebery Vinegar  
Fresh apple juice  
Bitters

*This drink is a sweeter style that has a long lasting raspberry finish with that hint of richness from the vinegar... The fresh green apple gives it the balance and finish.*
