Vibrant lemon sorbet and citrus flavours from the Chardonnay combine perfectly with Pinot Noir fruit, resulting in a wine with superb vitality and freshness.		
Brancott Estate Reserve Sparkling Sauvignon Blanc	12.00	45.00
The nose is characterised by aromas of ripe tropical fruit and vibrant passionfruit. The palate shows intense stone fruit flavours, and is full and textural with tantalising minerals.		
Hunters Miru Miru NV, Marlborough	13.00	62.00
The nose exhibits light yeasty characters with peach and citrus aromas. An elegant palate showing peach and citrus components followed by light berry fruits.		

SAUVIGNON BLANC

Brancott Living Land Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough	12.00	45.00
In this Sauvignon Blanc you'll find vibrant passionfruit sorbet aromas with capsicum and olive notes. The palate is intense, crisp and refreshing.		
Neudorf Sauvignon Blanc, Nelson	15.00	55.00
Green papaya with a squeeze of lime, pineapple, custard fruit (cherimoya) and melons. The wine exhibits a strong textural component.		
Ata Rangi Sauvignon Blanc, Martinborough	15.50	62.00
Aromas of passionfruit, persimmon, pear, honeysuckle and a hint of ruby grapefruit. A rich, finely textured and food-friendly wine.		
Man O War Sauvignon Blanc, Waiheke Island	13.00	49.00
Aromas of lemongrass and fresh herbs with tropical guava notes lead into a palate of vibrant acidity.		
Stoneleigh Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough		65.00
An intensely flavoured, full-bodied Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc with lively flavours of rich, ripe passion fruit tempered with a hint of dry grass.		
Triplebank Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough		57.00
Shows the typical tomato stalk characteristic this variety achieves in the Awatere Valley, with stone fruit and pineapple aromas, complemented by fennel herb notes.		

CHARDONNAY

Brancott Living Land Chardonnay, Marlborough	12.00	45.00
This wine benefits from ripe stone fruit flavours with a vibrant refreshing acidity. Matured in French oak barrels to add complexity to the palate.		
Carrick Chardonnay, Central Otago	15.50	59.00
A subtle mix of stone fruit, nectarine and white peach aromas, with hints of sweet ground almonds and toasted oak. Well balanced with a long creamy vanilla finish.		
Main Divide Chardonnay, Waipara	13.00	48.00
Citrus fruit, yellow plum, and peach aromas. It has good concentration and fruit weight with a creamy palate.		
Church Road Chardonnay, Hawke's Bay		64.00
An elegant, barrique-fermented Chardonnay with ripe stone fruit characteristics enhanced by toasty oak sweetness and subtle layers of complexity.		

PINOT GRIS

Brancott Living Land Pinot Gris, Marlborough	12.00	45.00
The nose is complex with guava and tropical fruit aromas with cinnamon and spicy pear notes. The palate is full-bodied, soft and round with sweet apple and pear.		
Stoneleigh Pinot Gris, Marlborough		65.00
Lifted nashi pear and tropical fruit flavours abound in this medium dry white wine.		
Maude Pinot Gris, Central Otago		59.00
Aromas of crisp pear and hints of lemongrass. A rich, voluptuous Pinot Gris with honeysuckle and poached pear flavours.		
Main Divide Waipara Pinot Gris, Waipara	13.00	48.00
Ripe fruit aromas of pears, yellow-fleshed peaches and fresh raw figs. A palate of concentrated fruit flavours, with a lingering finish.		

AROMATICS

Neudorf Brightwater Riesling, Nelson

Hint of limes washing over a bed of river stones. A Riesling always has the purity and elegance.

Look for a little fruit sweetness in the front palate followed by some spicy notes. (Easter buns and cinnamon) finishing with fresh tropical fruit.

Rich and luscious, this beautiful Riesling has aromas of nectarine, spice and honeysuckle notes.

On the palate the wine offers spicy peach, with overt apple strudel and honey flavours.

PINOT NOIR

Ata Rangi Crimson Pinot Noir, Martinborough

Dark cherry fruit and earthy complexity. There are savoury, gamey notes as well as hints of crushed rose petals on the nose.

The palate has a long, satisfying, flavoursome finish. Sales of this pinot noir support the work of Project Crimson, the charitable conservation trust established in 1990 for the protection and planting of New Zealand's remarkable red-flowering 'native Christmas trees', pohutukawa and rata.

Main Divide Pinot Noir, Waipara

There are aromas and flavours of cherries and red berry fruits with impressions of raspberries, mulberries and blackberries.

Camshorn Pinot Noir, Waipara

Deep garnet red in colour, the wine has aromas of lifted black cherry and plum with subtle oak, vanilla and clove spice. The palate is generous, showing wild berry, chocolate and an earthy complexity.

Brancott Living Land Pinot Noir, Marlborough

This wine presents dark cherry and plum aromas with liquorice and dried herb notes with savoury oak highlights.

The palate has abundant spicy fruit and well integrated tannins.

Presents the bright berry fruit characters so prized in this variety, along with dried herb, clove and cinnamon aromas and an earthy palate with silky tannins.

A bright-eyed red with hints of briar patch with a whiff of gun smoke. This is a classic South Island Pinot Noir, vibrant and fruity with a soft finish.

CABERNET SAUVIGNON/SYRAH/MERLOT/BLENDS

Te Mata Woodthorpe Syrah, Hawke's Bay

A bright purple colour and a fragrance of violets and raspberries, with an underlying hint of cardamom.

The palate is flavoursome and elegant, showing spiced blueberries and dried apricot characters, with soft tannins and great finesse.

Coupers Shed Syrah, Hawke's Bay

Dark berries with lifted violet notes and peppery spice. The palate is concentrated and rich with savoury nuances and supple tannins on the finish.

Main Divide Merlot Cabernet, Waipara

The merlot gives it sweet raspberry, wild blackberry and purple plum aromas and flavours, as well as a plump, rich mid-palate.

The cabernet provides a vibrant cassis-like character and a back-bone of muscley, ripe tannins which give structure and length.

A rich, complex Merlot Cabernet which displays lively berry fruit aromas complemented by spicy French oak flavours and firm fine-grained tannins.
